

Problem Sheet #6

This sheet provides instructions how to obtain the last problem sheet. The last problem sheet is personalized to every student and will be sent to each student encrypted with the student's `gpg` key. Hence, in order to obtain the problem sheet, you have to do the following:

- Create your own `gpg` key.
- Upload your `gpg` key to the `pgp.mit.edu` key server.
- Get your `gpg` key signed by a classmate such that there is a trust path from the instructors of the course to your `gpg` key. Make sure the signatures are uploaded to the `pgp.mit.edu` key server.
- Once the signatures are in place, send a PGP-signed email message to Johannes Schauer (`j.schauer@jacobs-university.de`) and he will then send you your personalized problem sheet.
